

Alcohol

All persons must be age 21 or older and provide legal identification to purchase alcoholic beverages. Management has the right to refuse service at any time. No alcohol may be brought into or taken out of the Lancaster Event Center (LEC) buildings or outdoor beer gardens. Campground residents may purchase packaged liquor either from a LEC Cafe/General Store or local store to bring to their camper. Package liquor must remain sealed and in the package until you return to your camper. Any intoxicated guests causing a disturbance during an event will be asked to leave the facility.

ATM Locations

For your convenience, there are automated teller machines (ATMs) located in the lobby of the Business Center, Exhibit Hall and the Lincoln Room/Multi-Purpose Arena entrance.

Food and Beverage

The Lancaster Event Center shall be the exclusive provider of food and beverage service inside all buildings and in designated outdoor eating areas. Please note that outside food and beverages, including coolers and deliveries of prepared from outside establishments, may not be brought into the Lancaster Event Center buildings by any individual, including attendees, participants, exhibitors, campers, employees, or subcontractors without written permission from Lancaster Event Center management. Visitors are not allowed to sell, give away, or distribute samples of any food or beverage items without written permission from Lancaster Event Center management. Paid campground residents are allowed to bring in outside food and beverage for their personal use within their campsite.

Lost and Found

During and after events, lost and found items are turned in and stored in LEC Office in the front of the Lincoln Room. Found items will be stored for 10 days following an event. The Lancaster Event Center is not responsible for any lost, stolen or misplaced items left in the building after the doors are locked and lights are turned off after the show.

Parking

See campground policies for your designated parking spot. There are some designated no parking areas clearly marked on the grounds. Violation of the posted "No Parking" signs shall be subject vehicle to towing and impoundment. No parking and vehicle/trailer parking in marked fire lanes at all times.

Concealed Handgun

Lancaster Event Center allows concealed handgun carry for Nebraska permit holders following Nebraska state laws. If your weapon is stored in your vehicle or camper it must be stored and locked. Certain shows may prohibit guns of all types e.g. Gun Shows, Fair Carnival.

Prohibited

For safety reasons, prohibited items include but are not limited to:

- Drugs, illegal substances or any paraphernalia associated with drug use
- Glass containers or other similar containers
- Fireworks
- Flags/Signs with poles
- Absolutely no use of drones and/or laser pens/pointers of any type
