Announcing the Pepsi Main Stage Concert Series & Cornhusker Country Bash of the 2016 Super Fair

Lincoln, NE— Come let the good times grow at the 2016 Lancaster County Super Fair, running Thursday, August 4 through Saturday, August 13. This year's event is welcoming a total of 15 bands over the course of 10 days, in both paid and free performances.

The Super Fair is proud to offer 10 nights of free entertainment on the Pepsi Main Stage including opening night with MWA Pro Wrestling, followed by 9 days of live bands with genres ranging from country, rock, reggae and blues, and your chance for fame with karaoke on the big stage. Enjoy a nice night of acapella from Blend out of Illinois, 50 celebrities on one stage with impressionist Mike Walker from Branson, MO, or one of the many local favorites that will definitely draw a crowd. Most noteworthy is the up and coming country duo Belles and Whistles who have just recorded in Nashville. Also to note, the brand new Bud Light Beer Garden Experience is coming to the Super Fair. So while the band is on break, you can watch the Olympics on flat screen TVs in the beer garden.

The Free Concert Series ends on August 13 with nine hours of fun from three bands in the Cornhusker Country Bash. Starting at 3pm Ashton Dugan & the Band Dave will kick off the show, then red dirt country favorite SwitchBak following at 6pm, and rock-influenced alt country act the Emmett Bower Band starting at 9pm. There is also the Double Headliner Show starring multi-platinum selling groups, Blackhawk and the Outlaws on Thursday, August 11. The 2016 Celebrity Concert will be held for the second straight year in Pavilion 4 of the Lancaster Event Center on 84th and Havelock in Lincoln where music lovers enjoyed the comfortable, relaxed environment and great acoustics for the Easton Corbin concert last year.
